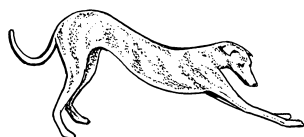

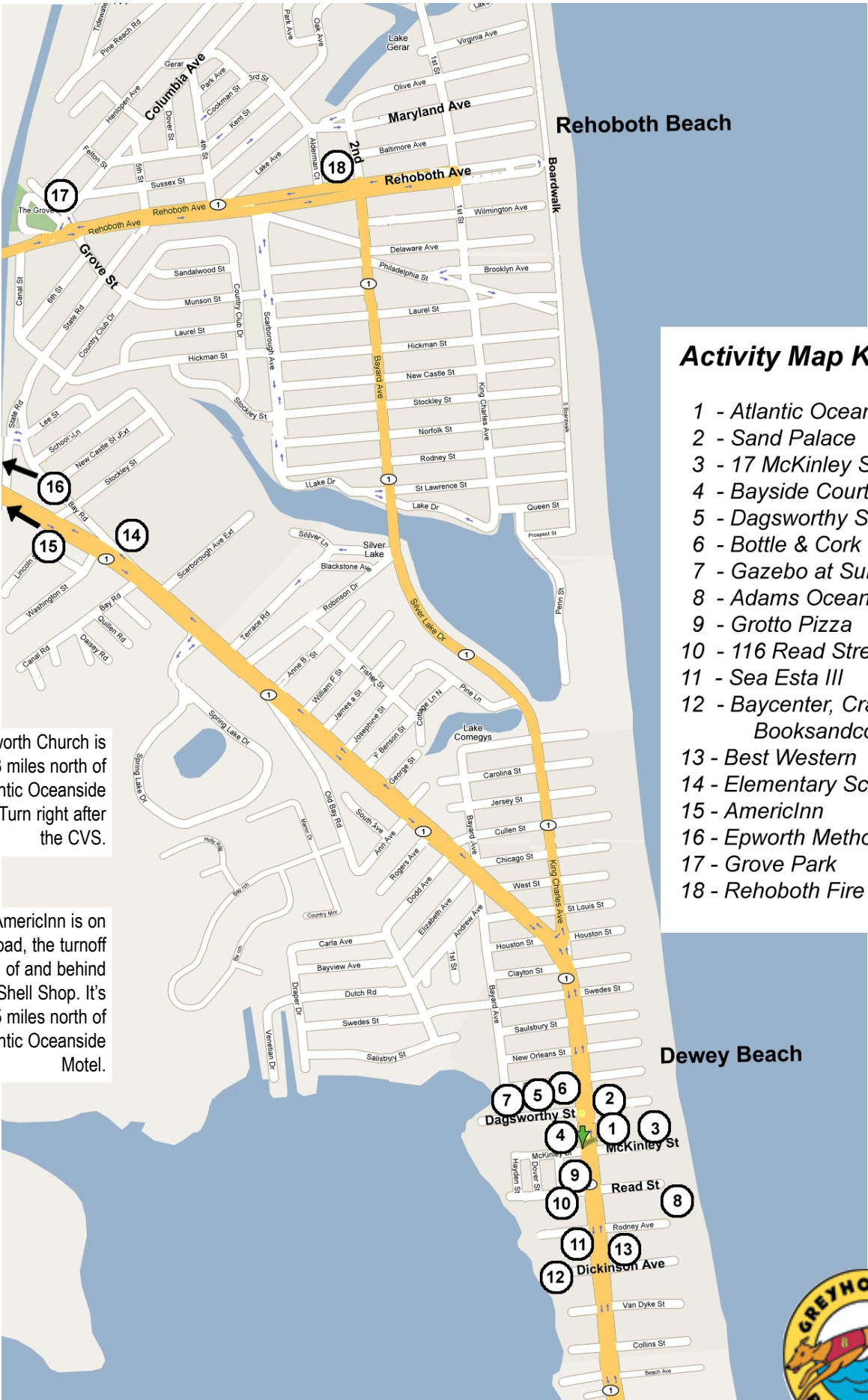

Epworth Church is almost 3 miles north of the Atlantic Oceanside Motel. Turn right after the CVS.

The AmericInn is on Airport Road, the turnout just south of and behind the Sea Shell Shop. It's about 3.5 miles north of the Atlantic Oceanside Motel.
